with, Anna and Mary Edelberg and lastly I do constitute and
appoint my wife Mary and my son Isaac Edelberg my executors to this
my last will and that they should not be held to heavy damages, where-
upon I have caused set my hand and affixed my seal this 5th day of April
One thousand eight hundred and six.

and at another court bill for the said County October the 1st
1856 On the motion of James Nisbett administrator
of the Estate of Jas. Macdonald dec'd & forth above mentioned
is granted sum whereupon he with Elizabeth Jenkins and
Peter Fore his executors entered into and acknowledged before
me for that purpose on the penalty of one thousand

A Court held for Prince Edward County the 15th day of June 1816
The last Will and Testament of Job Meadows deceased was
presented in Court and proved by the女兒 Mary Ferguson and Sarah
Wilson two of the witnesses thereto present that the same be recorded
and at another court held for the said County October the 9th
1816 On the motion of James Nimmis administrator
of the Estate of Job Meadows &c. with the will annexed
is granted him whereupon he with Elizabeth Jenkins &
Peter Fone his executors entered into and acknowledged there
bond for that purpose in the penalty of one thousand
dollars and conditioned according to law and took the
same required by law certificate for allowing letter of
probate which is due from the Probate
