body and mind do make this my last Will and Testament as followeth
I give and devise to my son John one Acre of Land more or less with
Land lying joining the said he now living one and likewise one negro
boy named Dick, and likewise one Negro Girl named Aggee and her
increase which he now hath in possession and likewise one negro
woman named Nicki:—

I give and devise to my son Quincy a Negro woman named Aggee
and her increase which he has had in his possession for years past
and of late has placed the said Aggee into the possession of his
daughter Susannah. Likewise give my Negro boy, Phill Fanning
son to Hannah Watson my son Quincy's daughter, & likewise give
my Negro boy named John to Elizabeth the Watson my son Quincy
daughter and one feather bed and furniture:—
I lend to my daughter Mary Chamberlaine Two hundred Acre of Land
more or less, agreeable to the long as Mary should at present, it being
time for her use, during her life and after

I give and devise to my son Quincy a Negro woman named Aggie
and her increase which he has had in his possession for years past
and of late has placed the said Aggie into the possession of his
daughter Susannah. Likewise give my Negro boy Phill Francis
son to Hannah Watson my son Quincy's daughter. Likewise give
my Negro boy named John to Elizabeth Watson my son Quincy's
daughter and one feather bed and furniture.

I lend to my daughter Mary Chambers Two hundred Cury of Land
more or less, Agreeable to the Cury as they stand at present it being
the land whereon she now Cury for her use during her life and after
her death I give the said Two hundred Cury of Land to her son
Isiah Chambers.

I give my negro Woman named Jane and her increase which
was lent to Sarah Chambers and by him. Wills to his said Children
as they are or otherwise by and with my personal consent.

1047. I give to my daughter Susannah one negro man named Cyprian which she
hath in possession and one Negro Girl named Samaria (Ceplyp
daughter and her increase);

I give to my son Samuel one negro Woman named Nancy
which he now hath in possession and her increase and one
Negro boy named Harry;

I give to my daughter Judith one negro boy named Cyprian, Harpers
son, and one Negro Woman named Sarah and her increase which
she now hath in possession and likewise one negro woman named
Fanny and her increase from this date and likewise one Negro
Girl named Jane Ceplyp daughter and her increase;

I give to my son Joseph one Negro boy named Billy and one Negro Girl
named Lilly and her increase which negroes he now hath in his
possession and one negro boy named James Samuels son;

I give to my son Sipe Watson one Negro woman named Lucy and her
increase from this date and likewise one Free Man named

increase from this date and likewise for Jane, Nancy and her increase,
likewise George and likewise Lydia and her increase and one Negro
boy named Matt which he now hath in possession.
I give to my son Isaac two Negroes Peter and Hannah and her
increase, which he now hath in possession and likewise one Negro
man named Solomon.

I give to my son Abner two ^{Negroes} named Little Dick and Jack, which he now
hath in possession and likewise Old Dick and likewise Betty and
her increase from this date and likewise Betty's daughter and her
increase. I likewise give him the land and plantation whereon
now live containing three hundred Acres more or less and likewise
my Cart and one Horse Carriage which he now hath in possession.
I have to my Grand daughter Sarah Nelson one Negro Girl named
Kate during her my said Grand daughter's life and after her death
I give the said Kate and her increase to be equally divided between
my said Grand daughter Sarah Nelson and her son.
It is my Will that my

a good many sons & daughters two Negroes have since
increased which he now hath in possession and likewise one Negro
man named Abram.

I give to my son Abner two ^{Negroes} named Little Dick and Jack, which he now
hath in possession and likewise Old Dick, and likewise beforesaid and
his increase from that date and likewise Betty, Cyprian daughter and her
increase I likewise give unto the said and plantation whereof
now here containing three hundred Acres more or less and likewise
my Cart and such like Cares which he now hath in possession.
I give to my Grand daughter Sarah Nelson one Negro Girl named
Kate during the my said Grand daughter's life, and after her death
I give the said Kate and her increase to be equally divided between
my said Grand daughter Sarah Nelson & Charles.

It is my Will that my Old Negro woman Agnes have totally to live
with the estate of my Charles who I have sent to live to live
infirm and not able to maintain himself in that case it is my
Will that she be maintained at the equal Expense of my Charles.

It is likewise my Will that all the residue of my personal Estate not
given away in this ^{my} Will shall be equally divided between my
Children:—

And all the above mentioned Gifts and Legacies in this my last
Will I give and devise to them and each of them as they are
mentioned and to their heirs forever agreeable to the true intent
and meaning of this my Will:—

It is my Will that my Estate be not Appraised nor my Executors
be held to give Security:—

And I do hereby appoint my Executors John Watson, Esq. William
and John Watson the Sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament

W. Watson whom I have hereunto set my hand and
fixed my seal this third day of February in the second year
hundred and Ninety seven

The Will was read over and
subscribed before signed

At a Court held for Larue & Howard County June 17th 1805 This last
Writ and Testament of John Watson deceased was presented in Court
and proved by the Oath of Drury Watson Jur. and Charles Allen
two of the Witnesses thereto ordered that the same be recorded. On the
Motion of John Watson and Joseph Watson two of the Executors then
named (no Security being required by said Writ) entered into and
acknowledged their bond for that purpose in the presence of One
Thurgood dollars and conditioned according to Law and took the
Oath required by Law. Certificate for obtaining a probate thereof
in due form is granted them, and leave given the other Executors
then named to take Direction thereof at another day.
