and real Estate in the following Manner To Robert my son I bequeath my land my horse
and more saddle, To him and his heirs forever only my son Robert is to pay, my Daughter Margaret
Twenty pounds in Money, for her part of the land, within the term of five years as she may have
Occasion for the said Money all my Other Estate Viz my Household furniture, Cooks Hays &c
I desire them to be equally divided between Robert and Margaret, I also desire that Robert
my son shall pay all my Just debts, This I Acknowledge to be my last Will and Testament
whereunto I set my hand and seal this Twenty second day of September 1799 these
signed sealed and delivered
