Item I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Grand Son Robert Baker
Two hundred Acres of Land with all the Improvements thereon
belonging, which include all the Land Ground & Buildings
whenever I Bequeath him Sixteen pound Ten shillings of the above
Current Money to him his Heirs and Assigns forever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Grand Daughter
Margaret Baker Seventeen shillings of the above
Current Money of Virginia with my Peaking bonnet
and saddle with my Brown falling gown & a Blue Hoop
Gown and Blue dusted pellicole taken when I was fourteen

Item I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Grandson John Baker
Seventeen pounds ten shillings of the above Current Money to
him his Heirs & Assigns forever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved Grandson John Baker
Twelve pound ten shillings of the above Current Money
to the amount of eight pounds six shillings & six pence
taken by him according to a paper account with the Baker

and Mary Anderson. And the remainder after my Last
full Debt and Legacies is paid off to be equally Divided
among my four Grand Children to wit Mary Anne
Margaret, and John Baber to him & their heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath to my Loving Son the Bachelor
Douglas Baber the Goods & Hire of my Negro
Isaac which is now in his possession

Now I give and bequeath to Mary Swallow one half of my
