I Mary Pinck of Prince Edward County being in tolerable health and of sound mind and memory Thanks be to God do make this my last will & Testament as to my worldly estate that God has been pleased to bless me with I dispose of the same in the following manner VIZ

Item I will that my sorrel horse by the name of Solley be sold and the money arising from the sale thereof be equally divided between my two sons VIZ Thomas and John, to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son William one feather bed marked W with such furniture as I shall leave with it to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Nathan one feather bed marked

N with such furniture as I shall leave with it to him and his heirs forever

Item my will and desire is that all the residue of my estate that I have in - - possession and all that is due me from my former estate

that is not yet mentioned both real and personal (except my saddle) be equally divided among my four sons VIZ Thomas John William

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be equally divided among my four sons VIZ Thomas John William  
and Nathan to them and their heirs forever  
Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Lucy <sup>as</sup> since my said to her and her  
heirs forever

I will that nothing herein contained be misconstrued for want of Law or  
form in Law I will that my estate be not appraised according to Law  
I do hereby appoint my sons Thomas John William and Nathan executors  
of this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
