Richey, to him & his Heirs forever.

I also give unto my Son Hugh Richey, all my black Smith Tools that are remaining,
to him & his heirs forever.

My Will & desire is that my Negro Farmer may have her Choice to live with any
of my Children during her Natural Life, without interruption of any one whatever,
I do constitute and Appoint Richard Foster, my whole & sole Executor of this my
last will & Testament revoking all Wills heretofore made by me, desiring no
appraisment to be made of my Estate & requesting no security be demanded
or given by the said Richard Foster, as my Exor. of this my Will, In witness
whereof I have set my hand & Seal this 4th day of April 1798.
