Miss I in the name of God Amen I Mary Kitchey of Prince Edward County being
sick & weak in body but sound in memory & knowing the uncertainty of human
life do make & ordain this to be my last Will & Testament in manner follow-
ing to wit, — I Give unto my sister ^{John} Hamilton the Plantation I now
own during her natural life and after her Death I give unto my nephew
John Elliot Kitchey the said plantation containing two hundred & ten
acres land be the same more or less — I Give unto my sister Christian Hamilton
Twenty head Cattle such as she may choose out of my stock of Cattle one yoke
work Steers two of the first Choice of my Horses (except the horse cart)
I also my household and Kitchen furniture (except the bed & such part of
provision as she may think proper) and such a part of my plantation where-
in as she may think necessary for the use of the plantation as also my
negro woman Fanny and my Negro Mary to be disposed of by her
as she may think proper & I Give unto my niece Mary Kitchey Dau-
ter of my Brother Hugh Kitchey my Negro William & my white
my Horse Jack as above excepted with my riding saddle & furniture.

Belonging them to her & her heirs forever, - My Will & desire is
that after my sister Christian Hamilton shall take such a proportion
out of my ^{real} household & kitchen furniture such as she may choose
all the remainder of what kind soever shall be equally divided between
my nephew John Elliott Metchey & his sister Mary Metchey to them &
their heirs forever as also all the remaining part of my stock of
Cattle and Hogs to be equally divided between my nephew John
Elliott Metchey & my ^{dear} & my ^{dear} Mary Metchey to them & their heirs forever -
I also give unto my nephew John Elliott Metchey the following
negroes Mary Fox & Cary as also all the remaining part of my
stock of Horses that is left after those ^{that} I have given away above
to him and his heirs forever - My Will and desire is that after
my decease that my estate agreeable to this my will shall be divided
at the expiration of the year at whatever time it may happen
each one to have their proportionable part - I give unto my
nephew Alexander Metchey my negro Oseba
to him and his heirs forever - My Will and desire is that all
my just debts be paid out of my cash that is already made
and after that my will and desire is that all the remaining
part thereof that is left after the debts are paid by

between my sister Christian Hamilton John Elliott Mitcheney and my
niece Mary Mitcheney to them & their heirs forever My further Will
is that my niece Mary Mitcheney shall live with my sister
Christian Hamilton as long as she continues single as one of the family
and my Will is that all the provision of meat that is laid in for
the ensuing year is for the support of my sister Christian Hamilton
my nephew John Elliott Mitcheney and my niece Mary Mitcheney -
I do constitute and appoint my sister Christian Hamilton and
my worthy friend Nathl Price Exor & Executor of this my last will
& Testament Revoking all Wills heretofore made by me desiring no
improvement to be made of my Estate nor no security given nor
required of my Exor & Executors of my last Will & in witness whereof
I have set my hand & seal this 23rd day of December 1805
