 Plantation Kentlands and after Her decease my land to be given

I believe my two sons Thompson Warner & George Warner and the rest of my
 estate to be be Equally I wish to be with my three children Thompson Warner & George
 Warner & Lucy and will lastly I wish to be with my three trustful well
 beloved friends John Jones Williams & James and my beloved wife Mrs.
 Warner lastly of this my last will & testament I wish to be with
 my wife and my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of September one
 thousand seven hundred & seventy eight.
