and eighty I Robert Hodgson of Prince Edward County being of sound
mind and perfect memory do make and declare this to be my Last Will and
testament in manner following First I leave and bequeath unto Constantine
my dearly beloved wife the Plantation whereon I now live with one hundred and
fifty Acres of Land adjoining the same during her Natural Life and after her
Death to return to my Youngest Son Charles, Item I give & bequeath to my son
Daniel four hundred Acres of Land by the Sale of a Patent dated the fifth day
of August one thousand seven hundred and fifty nine, Item I give and bequeath unto my
three eldest sons Three thousand one hundred and thirty Acres of Land lying in
Bedford County Equally divided amongst them by the date of a Patent dated the 18th
day of August one thousand seven hundred & fifty five Likewise I give and bequeath
unto three eldest Sons Elizabeth Davis and Jacob the remainder of my Land whereon I
now live being Six hundred and thirty Eight Acres to be equally divided amongst them
afterwards I give and bequeath unto my dear beloved Wife Constantine all my Negroes
with my Household Goods and ready Money I ratify and confirm this to be my last Will
and testament In witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal at Kingston
in the County of Prince Edward the seventh day of September one thousand seven hundred
and eighty
