make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner
and following, that is to say: In the first place, I devise my
body to the Earth to be Decently Interred at the discretion of my
Eors hereafter constituted and named, humbly trusting that
at the last day through the merits of our blessed Lord and glorious
Jesus Christ that it will receive a happy and glorious resurrection
and as to such worldly Estate as it hath pleased the divine
providence, to bestow upon me, I dispose of the same in manner
& form following: —

Viz. That at the Death of my beloved Wife Ann Holt my desire
is that my Land I have now in possession containing two
Hundred Acres be sold and equally divided amongst my children
hereafter named Viz. James, Robert, Josiah, Sarah, George, Jesse,
Leonard, John, David, & Isaac and I give to my daughter Sarah

at the last day through the merits of our blessed Lord and glorious
Jesus Christ that it will receive a happy and glorious resurrection
and as to such worldly Estate as it hath pleased the divine
providence, to bestow upon it I dispose of the same in manner
& form following: —

Viz. That at the death of my beloved Wife Ann Scott my desire
is that my Land I have now in possession containing two
Hundred Acres be sold and equally divided amongst my children
hereafter named Viz. James, Robert, Josiah, Sarah, George, Jesse,
Leonard, John, David, & Isaac and I give to my daughter Sarah
one cow also I give to my son Josiah feathers sufficient for one
bed and the rest of Stock Household & Kitchen Furniture & Planter-
tation Utensils to be equally divided amongst my six youngest
children Viz. George, Jesse, Leonard, John, David & Isaac by my
Cot^{rs} now named Thos Scott James Scott George Reid & Jacob Johns-
on whom I desire may see my body decently buried and witness my hand
and Seal this 17th March 1789
