this my last Will and Testament as follows to wit. I give  
and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Forty pounds Cash,  
I give likewise to my son William Fifty pounds Cash,  
likewise give to my son Hugh fifty pounds Cash, I  
to my Daughter Anical one negro boy named Jim, I likewise  
give to my Daughter Thebe forty pounds Cash, I likewise  
give to my Daughter Tabitha one Negro boy named Matt,  
I give to my Daughter Elizabeth five shillings Cash, I give  
to my son Charles one Tract of Land lying on Tattary Creek,  
adjoining Sammt Southwell and others, I likewise give  
him one Negro man named Lewis one feather bed and  
furniture and one young mare, I give to my Daughter  
Daisy one Negro Girl named Phillis, one feather bed &  
furniture, I give to my Daughter Judith one Negro Girl  
named Amy and one feather Bed and furniture, I give  
to my Daughter Patty one Negro Girl named Miller &  
one feather bed and furniture, I give to my son John  
four hundred Acres of Land, adjoining Richard Morton to  
be laid off in a Regular manner so as to Includ Halls  
old Plantation.

on a regular manner so as to include Harrison  
bed and furniture and one Negro boy named Landon, one feather  
Daniel four hundred acres of land adjoining Peter Houston  
and others to be laid off on a regular form, one Negro boy  
named Doctor one feather bed and furniture and one  
Young Horse, I give to my son Josiah all my land lying the  
North side of Buffalo river below Robertson's Mill Creek one  
Negro boy named Wall one feather bed and furniture and one  
Young Horse, I give to my son James all my land lying  
the south side of the said Buffalo river below the said  
Robertson's Mill Creek with twenty acres there of  
of the said River, to be laid off at the upper end of my land  
adjoining John Baudding's land and the River, one  
Negro Boy named Jack, one feather bed and furniture  
one Young Horse, I give to my child that my wife is  
now big with son or daughter all the rest of my land  
with the Plantation where I now live to be by  
her disposal after the death or marriage of my  
parent wife, and to give to him or her, The child my  
wife is now big with one Negro boy named Guy one  
feather bed and furniture and one young Horse  
~~and one young Horse~~

I give unto my dear and loving wife my Negro boy named  
major and my feather Bed and furniture.

And all the aforementioned Gifts and Legacies I give as  
they are mentioned to them and each of them and their  
Heirs forever, and also the remainder of my Estate I  
leave to my wife with the plantation whereon I now live  
during her Widowhood for the support of my Family &  
Schooled my Children, and at her Death or Marriage  
It is my Will and desire that, that part of my Estate  
left to her after the Legacies are paid all except the  
plantation before mentioned be equally divided among  
my eight youngest Children and that my wife is now  
big with, but if either the Children Negroes which I  
have given should die before my said Child that is given  
to comes of age to possess it, in that case it is my Will  
that the Value of the Negro that dies shall be made up  
out of that part of the Estate left my said Wife before it  
be divided, and it is likewise my Will that if either  
of my eight youngest Children or that my Wife now goes  
with should die before they come of age, that then part  
of my Estate be equally divided amongst those of my  
said nine youngest Children that survive, It is  
likewise my Will and desire that all my nine youngest

of my Estate be equally divided amongst those of my  
 said mine youngest Children that survive, It is  
 likewise my Will and Desire that as my said youngest  
 Children comes of age, they may have as much of my  
 Books and other Concessions as my wife shall think  
 proper for them to be delivered to them by my Executors  
 & to be preserved by them and their heirs forever, And  
 I do by these presents appoint and constitute my dear  
 Wife Sarah Price my son William Price and John Norton  
 the sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament.
