memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same knowing my appointed
end for all mine to do to make and Ordain that to be my last Will
and Testament in manner and form following to wit, First it is my
Will and doe that all my just debts be paid and that my Executors
hereafter named may manage and divide my Estate as is
his Character directed:—

First I give to my daughter Sarah Marshall a Negro woman named
Lucy and her appurtenances one Bed and Furniture one Cow and Calf one
Sow and Mare to her and her heirs forever.

Secondly I Give to my daughter Lucy Nile one negro woman named
Nelly and her appurtenances one Bed and Furniture during her life
and after her death to the heirs of her body and if she should die
before her children come of age my desire is that a Guardian should

before her Children come of age my desire is that a Guardian should
be appointed for them and the profits arising from the Negroes be
added to the support and education of her Children;

I also give to my daughter Mary W. Smith one Negro girl named
Celia and one hundred dollars one Bed and Furniture one Cow and
Calf and Twenty four pounds in lieu of a Horse to her and her heirs
forever.

I give to my daughter Elizabeth Fulk, one Negro Girl named Delcy,
one Bed and Furniture one Cow and Calf and one Bay Horse to her &
her heirs forever.

I give to my daughter Nancy when she comes of age or marry one Negro
Girl named Polly one Bed and Furniture one Cow and Calf and
twenty four pounds in lieu of a Horse to her and her heirs
forever.

I give to my son William one Negro boy named Robin one Bed &
Furniture one Cow and Calf and twenty four pounds in lieu of a
Horse to him and his heirs forever.

Bill and one hundred dollars, one Bed and furniture, one Cow and
Calf and Twenty four pounds in lieu of a Horse to him and his Mary
sonner.

I give to my daughter Elizabeth Fulk, one Negro Girl named Delcy,
one Bed and furniture, one Cow and Calf and one Bay Horse to her &
her Mary sonner.

I give to my daughter Nancy when she comes of age or marry one Negro
Girl named Polly, one Bed and furniture, one Cow and Calf and
twenty four pounds in lieu of a Horse of three Gallons to her and her Mary
sonner.

I give to my son Nathaniel one Negro boy named John one Bed &
furniture, one Cow and Calf and twenty four pounds and a Horse of
three Gallons out of my estate to him and his Mary sonner when
he comes of age.

I give to my son Vincent one Negro boy named Moses one Cow and

Value out of my Estate when he comes of age to turn and his
Heirs forever.

I give to my son William one Negro boy named Gom one Bed and
Furniture one Cow and Calf and twenty four pounds or a Horse of
that Value out of my Estate when he comes of age to turn and
his Heirs forever.

I give to my son Thomas one Negro boy named John one Bed and
Furniture one Cow and Calf and twenty four pounds or a Horse
of that Value out of my Estate when he comes of age to turn and
his Heirs forever.

I give to my son Joseph one negro boy named Will one Bed and
Furniture one Cow and Calf and twenty four pounds or a Horse of that
Value out of my Estate when he comes of age to turn and his
Heirs forever.

I give to my son John one negro boy named Shore one Bed and
Furniture one Cow and Calf and twenty four pounds or a Horse of that

I Give to my son John an negro boy named Shore, one tin and
gunstow, one Can and Cal and twenty four pounds, and three
of that Value out of my Estate when he comes of age to him
and his heirs forever:-

I Also Give to my daughter Fanny an Negro Girl named Betty,
one tin and gunstow, one Can and Cal and twenty four pounds
and three of that Value out of my Estate when she comes of age
a marry to her and her heirs forever:-

And of any of the Negros that I have given to my Children
should die before he comes of age, one is to be raised out of my
estate and put in his stead:-

Lastly the residue of my Estate both real and personal I leave to
my wife Elizabeth during her natural life and at her death
I leave my daughter Lucy and her heirs the part of my Estate, and
after her death to the heirs of her body, and the remainder of the
Estate to be equally divided among all my Children when they shall be

and her one friend, one Caroline Call and twenty four pounds
in Stones of Black Waller out of my estate when she died of age
a man to be and when being former:-

Swindler of any of the signs that I have given to my children should die before the course of age, one is to be raised out of my estate and put on the ground.

Heartily the wishes of my Estate both real and personal I leave to my beloved wife Elizabeth during her natural life and at her death then living daughter Lucy Neil one fourth part of my Estate, and after her death to the Heirs of her body, and the remainder of the Estate to be equally divided among all my Children above mentioned, Sincerely and lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend John Smith Esquire Justice and Master Marshall Executors of these my last will and Testament. At a Court held for Prince Edward county June the 17th 1800. His last will and Testament of
Richard Phillips deceased was presented in Court. *Thompson Moses Overton, John*
Phillips and John Woodfin being sworn say they are well acquainted with the hand
writing of the said Richard Phillips deceased, that the whole of the writing ^{contained in this will} together with
the signature, is they believe to be the hand writing of the said deceased. His Order
that the same be recorded. And at another Court held for the said county the 18th day
of July next following in the presence of John Beeth one of the Executors herein
named also with *Thomas Brumby, Thomas Rice, Thomas Clarke and*
John T. Ligon his Executors interdicts and Acknowledged their bond for
that purpose in the penalty of Twenty thousand dollars and conditions according
to law and took the Oath required by Law. Certificate for obtaining a precept thereof
in due form is granted him and leave giving the other Executors herein named
to take Execution at another day. *Test. Benj. Watling &c*
