 10 I Give unto my beloved son Thomas Waddell son of Elizabeth Waddell
 Dec. three Negroes strong, dark & handsome one feather bed & furniture to
 him and his Mary forever.

11 I Give unto my son John Waddell eight negroes, namely Leath, Pot, Sells,
 Rachell, Sam, Mary, Sam, & Peter, with their increase to him and his
 Mary forever; & likewise give and bequeath unto my son John Waddell
 the tract of land whereon I now reside on containing 346 Acres,
 the same more or less to him and his forever; & likewise give unto my
 son John Waddell the Tract of land purchased of Rachel Indian
 containing 14 Acres, the same more or less to him and his Mary forever.
 I likewise give unto my said son John Waddell all my household and
 kitchen furniture and stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep & Hogs and every article
 of plantation utensils to him and his Mary forever;

Now be it understood that it is my desire that the respective legacies
 above named are not to be drawn from my estate until the death of
 my wife Sarah Waddell excepting the property I have already delivered

my wife Frances Muddell excepting the property I have already disposed
before the signing & sealing of this instrument.
