to consider my wife entitled to a child's part when all the
children have left her, my will is that my wife shall never
be called to account of the management of the estate while
in her possession, at the death of my wife my will is that
my land be sold and the money equally divided among
all my children except my son Joel he being already
provided for in that respect by the will of his grandfather.
I hereby appoint Francis Watkins Jr, Thomas Watkins, Leffe
Watson and Richd W. Venable Executors of this my last will -

court refused to take upon themselves the burden of the execution
thereof and on the motion of John Morton Administration of the
Estate of the said Robert Watkins deceased is granted him (with
the will annexed) Thereupon he with Richard W. Venable, Lam.
Booker and Thomas Haskins his securities entered into and
