Divided between all my Brothers and Sisters to them and their heirs forever.

Item I leave what debts is owing to me to pay all my just and lawfull
debts and the Remains of the money paid to be Equally Divided between
all my Brothers and Sisters to them and their heirs forever.

Having my Brother John Martin and Hugh Martin Executors to this my last
will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this Sixth Day of March in the year of our Lord 1792
