and Ordain this to be my last Will & Testament in manner and

and their future Increase, to him this heirs for ever.

Then I give and bequeath unto my friend Elizabeth Fisher Smith My Negro
Woman Molly to her, this heirs forever.

Then my Desire is that after all my Just Debts, are paid. by my Executor,
if there should be money left in his hands my desire is that he pay to
Elizabeth Hastings Daughter of Col. Thomas Hastings the sum of Fifty pounds
at her coming to age or marrying.

All the Rest of My Estate of what kind soever. I give to my friend
Col. John Vase.

And Lastly I do appoint my friend Col. John Vase Executor of this
my last Will & Testament desiring that my Estate be not sold

My Negro Servant two son Castles and my Negro Woman Lucy.
and their future Increase, to him this heirs for ever.

Then I give and bequeath unto my friend Elizabeth Fisher Smith my Negro
Woman Motty to her, Ther heirs forever.

Then my Desire is that after all my just Debts, are paid. by my Executor,
if there should be money left in his hands my desire is that he pay to
Elizabeth Hastings Daughter of Col. Thomas Hastings the sum of Twenty pounds
at her coming to age or marrying.

All this Rest of My Estate of what kind soever. I give to my friend

Col. John Nash.

And Lastly I do Appoint my friend Col. John Nash Executor of this
my last Will & Testament desiring that my Estate be not appraised,
and do Ratify and Confirm this and no other ^{to be} my last Will.
