and memory do make constitute and nominate my last  
will and testament in manner and form following, to wit,  
I give and Devise to my son Charles Whitlock three hundred  
and ninety Acres Land whereon he now lives to him and  
his heirs forever, I also give and Devise to my son Jacob  
Whitlock sixty five pounds current money,  
I give and Devise to my son William Adams Whitlock  
three hundred and ninety acres of land between my son  
Charles and George Morris, and lying on both sides of the  
manifold, also fifteen pounds current money and one  
feather bed and furniture, to him and his heirs forever  
I give and Devise to my son John Whitlock three hundred  
and ninety Acres of Land it being the land and plantation  
whereon I now dwell also two negroes to wit, Nat &  
Jane, with the Increase of them and Jane from this time  
also one feather bed and furniture, to him and his

I give and devise to my Daughter Mary Wells during  
her Natural Life two hundred acres of Land in Charlotte  
County on a tract called the great Oak, also one Negro  
Woman named Famer, with her Increase from this Time  
and after said Daughter, because my wife and I were in  
that the said Land and Negro with her Increase, if any be,  
Equally divided between my three Grand Children, Elizabeth  
Seddonia and Mary Wells or the Survivor of them and  
their Heirs forever.

I give and devise to my Daughter Milla Whitlock four  
Negroes, to wit, Hannah, Pagan, Jane & Chelsey, also  
two Cows and Calves one Feather Bed and Furniture with  
the Increase of the said Negroes from this Time, to her and  
her Heirs forever.

I give and devise to my Daughter Mary Wells two Cows  
and Calves and all the household Furniture and Stock  
which I purchased of Peter Wells late to her and her

I have and hereby do give Charles, Josiah and  
William Adams Whittlock three fifty pounds Covenants  
being to each of them like and out of my Estate as soon  
as possible and after they are paid then my will and  
Desire is that all my Estate that has not been already  
mentioned be equally divided between my five  
Children, Elizabeth Foster, Josiah Whittlock William  
Adams Whittlock, John Whittlock and Abigail Whittlock  
Thomas Fournoy George Moore and William Proctor  
are appointed Executors, In Witness whereof I have  
Testator hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his  
Seal this 21st day of October 1769
