

In the name of God amen the fourteenth day of April 1795 I Stephen Neal of Prince

Edward County being sick and weak but of perfect mind and memory, and knowing it is appointed for all men
once to die do make this my last Will and Testament. as touching any worldly Goods I dispose of them
in the following manner Viz. Impudence I lend to my beloved Wife Edith ^{Neal} during her natural life 50

Acres of Land beginning at Perkinsons land on the main Road from Thence to the mouth of the Spring her and
Thence for quantity taking in the houses and orchard, also I lend to her for the above term one Negro man Houghton
together with my stock of Horses, Cattle and Hogs also all my household and Kitchen furniture (except 2 Feather
beds her after devised,

Item I Give and bequeath to my son Stephen Neal 20 Acres of Land lying on the north side Smalls
beach, Thence up a branch line on John Toulhs land and mine, Thence to my back line, Thence for quantity
to the north fork said Smalls beach. Thence down said beach as it meanders to the beginning
binding him to pay my son John Neal the sum of Twenty pounds within the Term of three years from the date hereof
as also to build a Dwelling house for his mother on the said Shore and her as above upon which person I give
to him and his heirs forever,

Item. I Give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Neal 20 Acres of Land on the South side Smalls beach
in the fork also one Feather bed and furniture of the first choice, all which I give to her and her heirs forever

Item. I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Vittumate Neal 20 Acres of Land both said of from my back line
to the north fork of Smalls beach, also my son Stephen said, also one feather bed and furniture which
I Give to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I Give and bequeath to my three sons William Neal, Saba Neal, and Phillip Neal all the

Land and household goods and furniture equally mine and mine or my heirs

Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter
in the first also one feather bed and furniture of the first choice, all which I give to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Vitturath Neal 20. Acres of Land to be laid off from my back line
to the north fork of Snake Creek, also one feather bed and furniture which
I give to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my three sons William Neal, Laban Neal, and Phillip Neal all the
remaining part of my Land not heretofore devised containing exactly one acre more or less to be
divided among them then according to Quality and Quantity as they arrive at age or marry,

Item. I give and bequeath to my son Zachariah Neal the 50. Acres of Land I lent to my wife as afore
mentioned to be enjoyed by him after he decease, My Will and desire is that every thing I have lent my
Wife (except the Land) should be sold to the highest bidder, at twelve months Credit and the money
from thence arising to be equally divided among my eight Children Wiff. John Neal, Stephen Neal,
Polly Neal, Rebecca Neal, William Neal, Laban Neal, Phillip Neal, and Zachariah Neal.

I Will that nothing herein contained be mis construed for want of Time or Time of day, and I do
renewable testament and appoint my Loving Wife Executor and my truly friend Benjamin Hawkins
Executor to this my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal the day and year first above Written.

I Give unto my Nephew Hugh Ritchie son of Hugh Ritchie the sum of Twenty pounds
lawfull money of Virg^a to him and his heirs forever
I Give unto my Niece Mary Ritchie daughter of Alexander Ritchie and my boy or man that is now
