Sally each and equal Part thereof the Estate herein bequeathed to my son
Samuel I give to him and his heirs forever & it is my will that so long as my
Daughters Molley & Sally live single that they have the free use & Liberty of
their Transfer in my dwelling ^{house} without the formal or indorsement of my
Executors
It is my further will that my son Samuel & Esau should depart this life
without leaving open in that case the said bequest to him & his
Part of my Estate bequeathed him & his heirs forever & bequeath into my said two Daughters
Molley & Sally to be equally divided between them by my Executors hereafter
named untill my said two Daughters should agree on a Division themselves
which Estate I bequeath to them and their heirs forever & should it so happen
my Samuel) it is my will that all the Negroes now possessed of be continued
in my Plantation the next year to make up
Lastly I do constitute & appoint my son & his heirs & friends
Nathaniel Winable & Thomas Watson Executors of my will & testament
wholly touching & declaring void all other wills before
herebefore made in which I have been or shall be named

Samuel & desire that my Executors hereafter named may divide my estate

Part of my Estate have called him down and brought into my said two Daughters
Molly & Sally to be equally divided between them by my Executors hereafter
named unless my said two Daughters should agree on a Division themselves
which estate I bequeath to them and their heirs forever & should it so happen
my ^{son} Samuel) It is my will that all the Negroes then possessed of be continued
in my Plantation the next year to make up

Lastly I do constitute & appoint my son the said John & friends
Nathaniel Winable & others that their executorship & the said
and testament hereby be making & declaring void all other wills by me
heretofore made In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this seventh Day of December in the year of Christ one thousand seven hundred

and seventy seven
