and Thomas Clark to be unto them and there heirs forever Except

of my Estate should be equal to mine and
unto Thomas Clark to be unto them and there heirs forever I give
my Farm and path which I have given unto my Grandson Thomas
Clark to be Belonged to him after my wife decease and my will and
desire is that my Estate should not be divided Lastly I do
appoint my Beloved Sons John Clark and Thomas Clark
to settle my affairs after my death and divide my whole Estate
above mentioned and if either of them should die before Division
then the Son of John Clark named Thomas Clark is to act in his
Fathers stead and if my Son Thomas Clark should die before then
his Son William Clark to act in his stead in dividing my Estate
and Lastly I appoint my two Sons John and Thomas Clark my
Executors to this My Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Seven day July one
