she hath now in her possession to her & her heirs &

Item I Leave to my Wife Mary Jackson all the rest of my Estate  
during her natural life & at her Death the Land that Bought of  
John Jackson to be sold and all the rest of my Estate to be equally  
Divided amongst all my Children plainly as following Elizabeth

The hath now in her possession to her then nurse

Ann - I leave to my Wife Mary Jackson all the rest of my Estate during her natural life & at her Death the Land that Bought of John Jackson to be sold and all the rest of my Estate to be equally Divided amongst all my Children & heirs as following Elizabeth Tucker, James Jackson, Agnes Fallow, Mary Laurence Thomas Jackson, William Jackson, Sally Holt, Francis Jackson, Millie Jackson, Tabitha Foster to them and their heirs forever & And lastly I do appoint my sons James Jackson & Francis Jackson Executors of this my Last Will & Testament.
