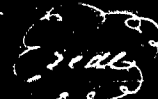


In the name of God Amen I Thomas Melloy of Downe, Pa and County living, weak

children; Also it is my desire that any part of my stock and household furniture shall be sold if my
Exors and Executors shall think it necessary for the payment of my debts. Lastly I do
hereby appoint my Wife Sarah Melloy Executrix, George Green and Oliver Hastings Executors of
this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fifteenth day of August, in the
Nineteenth year hundred and ninety five.

In the name of God amen the fourteenth day of April 1795. I Stephen Neal of New
Bedford County being sick and weak but of perfect mind and memory, and knowing it is appointed for all men
once to die do make this my last Will and Testament. as touching my worldly goods I dispose of them
in the following manner Viz. I give and bequeath I lend to my beloved Wife Edith ^{Neal} during her natural life 50
Acres of Land beginning at Robinsons Mill in the main Road from thence to the mouth of the Spring for and
thence for quantity taking in the houses and orchard, also I lend to her for the above Term one negro man Hoxford
together with my stock of Horses, Cattle and Hogs also all my household and Kitchen furniture (except 4 Trunks
which have after devised,

Item I give and bequeath to my son Stephen Neal 50 Acres of Land lying on the north side Smith
Creek, thence up a branch hole in John Smiths land and mine, thence to my back stile, thence for quantity
to the north fork said Smiths Creek thence down said Creek as it measures to the beginning
