Thirdly I give and bequeath to my brother David Anderson one Negro man named James and all my wearing apparel and every thing also of my Estate be it of what Nature or quality soever I give it him and his Heirs forever; And I constitute and appoint my two friends Jeffery Robertson and John Gannaway Executors of this my last Will and Testament, and further I desire that there be no appraisement on my estate; Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty first of August one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Eight.
