revoking all others that has hitherto been made by me as Witness my hand and Seal this twentieth  
day of March one thousand seven hundred & ninety six.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Bauldwin One Negro man named Dick, One  
Negro Woman named (black) Phillis and five pounds Cash to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Bauldwin One Negro man named  
Jesse and fifty pounds Cash to be paid by my son Samuel out of his Legacy to him &  
his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Bauldwin one Negro man named Daniel, &  
Negro Woman named Nancy with all his increase. One Negro girl named Kate, one  
of the ageable to a line I have marked between myself & my said son, William  
three hundred Acres more or less to him and his heirs forever. Also one third part of a

Book debts due me. Item, I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Bouldron one negro man named Bob, One Negro man named Jacob, One tract land containing more hundred acres more or less One Copper Hill to him and his heirs forever. Also One negro boy named Harry to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Cook one negro Woman named Annica, one Negro Woman named Lueky with all their increase, and ten pounds Cash to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Davis one negro Woman named Jane, one negro Woman named Jude with all their increase to her and her heirs forever. Item, I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Molly Price one negro Boy named David to <sup>her</sup> and bequeath to her heirs forever.

Item I give, to my grand daughter Nancy Price one negro boy named Jesse to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Sally Price one negro girl named Jane to her & her heirs forever.

Item, I lend to William Price of Prince Edward County during his natural life the following Negroes (to wit) One negro Woman named Dice, one negro girl named Mytilla, one negro boy named Sam, and one negro boy named Charles and at his death the above lent Negroes, with all their increase to be equally divided between my above named Grand Children -

(to wit) Molly Price, Nancy Price & Sally Price, and their heirs forever.

Item I send my loving wife Ann Bauldwin during her natural life or Widowhood, one Negro man named Sambo, one Negro man named George, one Negro Woman named Agg, one Negro Woman named Molly, one Negro Woman named Phillis, One Negro boy named Tom, one Negro boy named James, One Negro girl named Kate, one Negro boy named Syrus with my Manor plantation, Plantation Uttered, house hold and kitchen furniture Stocks of Horses, Cattle, Hogs, and Sheep one third part of bonds & book debts due to me.

Item at the death of my Wife I give and bequeath to my Son Samuel Bauldwin all the Legacy I have lent to my wife except one Negro girl named Kate (who is devised to my son William) to him and his heirs forever. Also one third part of my Bonds & book debts due me.

Item my Will & desire is that my Negro Woman Agg & Volley, after my Wifes death shall have liberty to go to either of my Children they may choose.

I do nominate and appoint my sons William Bauldwin & Samuel Bauldwin Executors of my last Will & Testament, my will is there shall be my appraisement. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and year above written.

This last will and testament of William Bauldwin deceased was presented to Court and proved by Francis Thornton and Ralph Porter two of the Witnesses here.

ordered that the same be recorded, on the motion of William Bauldwin and Samuel Bauldwin the  
 Executors therein named who with Robert Kelso, Francis Thornton and Dudley Bartholomew  
 secretaries entered into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose in the sum of ~~the~~ <sup>one</sup> ~~thousand~~  
 thousand pounds, and conditioned as <sup>the</sup> Law directs and took the oath required by Law, Certificate  
 for obtaining a Probate of the will in due form is granted them.
