

At the Name of God Amen I William Cary
of Prince Edward County and Colony of Virginia be-
ing in a low state of Health, being in my proper
Senses and Memory, calling to mind the Uncertain
stay of Mortal in this present World, do make this
my last will and Testament in the Manner and
Form following, To wit,

Item. I give and bequeath ^{unto} my son Edward Cary one
Negro man named Antony, One Negro woman named
Juno, One Negro girl named Agg, one Negro girl
named Ellen, and one large Chest to him and
his heirs and assigns forever.

Item. I give and bequeath ^{unto} my son William Mayner
Cary, one Negro man named Lamson and one
Negro woman named Sarah, one Negro girl named
Dookey, and one Negro girl named Judith also one

my chest which is calling mine to him and his heirs and
assigns forever.

I have and bequeathed to my ^{three} Daughters Mary, Jane and Elizabeth
Wynn, Martha Miller being twenty shillings (pounds) Money of Virginia
to be equally divided to them and their heirs forever.

339 I have all my rest of my Estate be it of what kind soever besides what
has been heretofore mentioned and gave away only I gave unto my son
William Haynes Cary my riding mare the rest to be equally di-
vided between my two sons Harwood Cary and William Haynes
Cary, they and their heirs forever.

I appoint my son Harwood Cary and William Haynes Cary my heirs
and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking
all former Wills by me made declaring this and only this to be my
last Will and Testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my seal this twentieth day of March
one thousand seven hundred and eighty four.
