in plain Writing Last Will and Testament in manner and form following
I do first and Principally Recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God who gave it me and my Estate my Will and Desires should Wholly
Remain in my Well beloved Wife Mary Harrison's Possession during her
Lifetime do except the sum of one Hundred Pounds which I give and devise
unto my Well beloved Daughter Fanny Harrison which I purpose
to be raised as aforesaid and paid to her at the Age of
Twenty one years on her day of Marriage, and the sum of Fifty Pounds which
I give to my Well beloved Daughter Jane Harrison, which I purpose to be
raised as aforesaid and paid to her at the Age of Twenty One years on her
day of Marriage, and after my Wife's decease or after my death I give to
my well beloved son Aaron Harrison One Negroe Boy named Perry
I give to my Well beloved son Christopher Harrison

I Give to my Wellbeloved son Christopher Harrison one Negro Boy named Perry.
I Give to my Wellbeloved son James Harrison one Negro Boy named
Milk Give to my Wellbeloved son Ben^d Harrison one Negro Boy named
