In the Name of God Amen, I Charles Goodrich being Weak and Sick of Body but of sound and perfect memory, do hereby constitute and Appoint this my Last Will and Testament as follows; first I give my Soul into the hands of my Saviour Jesus Christ, through whose merits and mediation I do assuredly hope for the Remission of my Sin and Salvation of my Soul, and my Body to be buried in such decent Christian manner, as my Executors hereafter named shall think fit, and as to my Worldly Estate I leave as followeth Viz
I give to my Daughter Ann Hamlin in Consideration of the Debt which she owes to the Estate of her deceased Husband, all my personal Estate, except one Bed and furniture, which I give to my Daughter Sarah Goodrich.
I give and confirm to my Daughter Lucy Goodrich and her heirs forever that Negro Woman and her increase, which is now in dispute between her and Peter Mingo, named in the Will.
I do appoint my Daughter Ann Hamlin to be sole and Sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament. Witness my hand and Seal this 6th day of December 1725

At a Court held at Merchants Hope for Prince George County, on the 2nd day of Tuesday in June, being the first day of the month of June 1726
The Court read and considered the Last Will and Testament of Charles Goodrich deceased and the same being found to be the Last Will and Testament of the said Charles Goodrich deceased the Court did accordingly give and grant the same to the said Ann Hamlin and her heirs forever.
