I commit to the Earth to be decently interred according to the discretion of my
Excutrix hereafter named, and as for that Worldly Estate which it hath pleased
Almighty God to bestow upon me, I give and bequeath it in the manner following
Vizt I give to James Price a brown heifer with calf.

Item I give to Sarah Price a Dyed heifer.

Item I give to James Wilbrey a ^{Prince of George Co Wills 1713-1728} ~~black~~ cow with ~~her~~ increase.

Item I give to James Wilbrey ^{www.virginiapioneers.net} forty shillings, & a year & one year schooling provided
he lives with my Excutrix untill he is of the age of Twenty one years.

Item All the Rest and residue of my Estate both Real & personal I give and be-
queath to my Loving Wife Jane and her Daughter Mary Dewell, to be
Equally Divided between them. Item I do hereby Ordain and Appoint my Loving Wife
Jane Excutrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and do renounce & revoke
all former Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and cleave this third day of January in the year of our Lord, One thousand
Seven hundred & Twenty five.
