Decease and two hogs and my large Chest for the use of
five hogs after my wife's Decease.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Williams
my negro man Robin after my wife's Decease or Marriage
Item my will and desire is that my negro man Belton
and my horse Paulins be sold to discharge my debt
by my Executors which I shall hereafter appoint
Item the remainder of my Estate which I have

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not before divided I give to my three Daughters Mary
Brookwell Sarah Williams & Anne Williams
Item the part of my Estate that I have left my loving
wife during life I desire may be equally divided at
her Decease or marriage between my two sons Daniel
& David Carter.

And my will is that my Estate be not appraised
Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my two sons
Daniel and David Carter to be my whole & sole Executors
of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby
