conveniences thereto belonging during the life of my son
Robert and no longer only I give my son Robert a tract of
land a house and a Sintery part of the above said

Now I give unto my daughter, wife of the young man, and I hope by so
 doing, a man who with having a character who is and all the
 convenience thereunto belonging during his life and widow
 and no longer only I give my son the best of my estate and
 build and repair and find any part of the share and he
 shall not at any time be troubled and I shall thereafter my love
 be as much as I can give to him and his wife and his
