one Feather Bed and Furniture, one Iron Pot, two Dishes
and half a Dozen Plates, and one Mare and Saddle

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Nathaniel Tatum my
negro Fellow called Will, one Iron Pot.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Robert Tatum and to
his Heirs forever the one half of my Land I now live on
to be divided from a Hooping Hickory Standing near the
Clabornes Old Road and then a Strait course to the Swamp
meaning the lower part of the said Land, Likewise give
my said Son, two Cows and Calves and one yearling, a
pewter Dish, Basin, and half a Dozen plates, and one
Small Gun.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Bethe Tatum

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betty Tatum
one Feather Bed and Furniture one Cow and Calf, a winter
Bason and two plates and my large Table.

Item I give and bequeath to my son David Saturn the other half of my Land Inow live on ~~not mentioned before~~ and to his Heirs forever and one Case with thirteen Bottles, a Feather Bed and Furniture, Two Cows and Calves, two pewter Dishes and half a Dozen plates, and all the remaining part of my Estate not mentioned at my Wifes
