in the County of Prince George Smith, being sick and weak of Body, but of sound
and perfect mind and memory, praise be therefore given to Almighty God, who
and I deem this my present Last Will and Testament in manner form and
that is to say First and principally I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty
God, hoping through the Merits, Death and Passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ, to
have full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins, and to inherit Everlast-
ing Life, and my Body I commit to the Earth to be decently Buried in the
Discretion of my Executors hereafter named, and as touching the Disposition of
all such Temporal Estate, as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon
me, I give and Dispose thereof as followeth.

First I Will then hereby bequeath and Generall Charges be paid to the
then I give and bequeath unto my Son Joshua all my Land Lying on the
S.E. side of the Cattaraugus Swamp, the said Swamp to divide it from the other
part of the said tract as far as the Swamp extends itself, thence along the
said Swamp Branch to a White Log which the Line crosses, to the end to the
hair for ever. —

he attains to the full age of Twenty and One year, with a Couch, 2 Chairs, 2 Dishes,
One being Larger, two plates, and four spoons, to be delivered to him at the said time.
Item. I give and bequeath unto my son William the plantation wherein I now
Dwell with the remaining part of my Land lying on the East side of the Catfish
creek, to him and to his Heirs for ever.

I do hereby guarantee him the said William a Table with a Turned Frame, 2 Chairs,
2 Dishes, one being larger, two plates and four spoons, my Common prayer Book,
and Mr Brooks his Cypress of Gold, with a Cow and Calf, and two Sows, Pigg, to be
Delivered to him when he attains to the age of Twenty and One year.
Item. I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth West, the Desk, 2 Chairs, 2 Dishes,
three plates, and four spoons, and a small Bible with the psalms thereto belong-
ing, a small Bible, and a Treatise entitled The Worthy Communicant, with
One Cow and Calf, and one Sow and Pigg, to be delivered to her at the day of
her marriage.

All the rest and residues of my Estate, Goods, Chattels whatsoever I do
give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife Elvance Jackson full and Sole
Exectrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and I do hereby revoke, Disannul
and make Void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made. In
Witness whereof I the said William Jackson to this my Last Will and Testa-
ment set my hand and Seal this thirteenth Day of October, Anno Dom. 1726

given my Plantation to my youngest son, yet my Will, sheweth the meaning is that
my Wife shall keep and enjoy the sd. Plantation during the Term of her Nat-
ural Life without any let, Hindrance or Molestation whatsoever.

At a Court held at Fitzgeralds, for the County of
Prince of George Co. Wills 1713-1728
the second Tuesday in May, being the
Fourth Day of the said Month June 1727

The above written Last Will and Testament of William Jackson
