ing part of this patent by me sold to Robt. Fountaine as by a sale from under my hand will appeare:) TO HAVE AND TO HOLD Ye remaining part of ye patent Robert Fountaine only
excepted to him ye sd Robert Smith his heires or assignes forever in as large and ample
manne to all intents and purposes as is expressed in ye within patent & further I ye sd
James Cason doe promise & bind myself my heirs Extr. and Administr. that I will from time
to time & at all times hereafter forever save defend keep harmless & undamified ye sd Robert
Smith his heires and assignes from all pson or psons whatsoever shall or may claime any
part of ye sd land wthin ye patent belonging now to ye sd Robert Smith by vertue of any for-
mer survey and in confirmacon of all and every ye above sd premises ye sd James Cason & Ann
his wife who doth hereby testifie her free consent & voluntarily good will to all and evry
of ye abovesaid premises have hereunto set their hands and seales this 31st of May 1696.
