

To all to Whom it Now shewes that I the said Edward Norr Esq. Gov. &c. do with the advice & Consent of the Council of State accordingly give and grant unto Richard Holmes a tract of land containing two hundred fifty two acres lying and being in the County of Henrico on a Creek known by name of Swift Creek (viz) beginning at a Corner black Oak belonging to the land of Cap. John Bowling & running thence on his Line South crossing Swift Creek two hundred & six poles to a black Oak thence leaving his Line & run East two hundred poles to a black Oak thence North one hundred & fifty four poles crossing Swift Creek to a black Oak thence West North West one hundred & seventy eight poles to a pine on Cap. John Bowling's Line thence on his Line South South West forty six poles to the place it began including the aforesaid two hundred & fifty two acres of land the said land being due unto the said Richard Holmes by and for the Importation of five persons into this Colony whose names are to be in the Records mentioned under this patent To have & to hold to & to be held to Yielding and paying as Provided is Given under my hand & the Seal of the Colony this 2. Gov. &c. do with the advice & Consent of the Council of State accordingly give and grant unto John Hopkins one hundred & fifty eight acres of land lying in Princeps Anne County on both sides the Gum Swamp beginning at a Beech a Corner tree of John Muddens land & running thence crossing the said Swamp North Westerly forty two degrees Twenty poles to a Beech thence North Westerly Sixty six degrees Ninety two poles to a pine thence North Westerly forty two degrees one hundred poles to a Maple thence South Westerly Eighteen degrees one hundred & six poles to a Gum standing by a great poguerson called the green Sea thence South Easterly forty five degrees two hundred & eighteen poles to a white Oak standing in Muddens Line thence bounding in part on the said Line to the first mentioned station it being all the land found within the Bounds of a patent of two hundred & ten acres granted the said John Hopkins dated the twenty fourth day of April 1703 the said land being due unto the said John Hopkins by and for the transportation of four persons into this Colony whose names are to be in the Records mentioned under this patent To have & to hold to & to be held to Yielding and paying as Provided is Given under my hand and the Seal of the Colony this 2. Day of November anno Domini 1705
