Burrough to be my trustees to see this my last will & testament. performed & for wt worldly estate it have pleased God to bless wth I give and bequeath as followeth; Item I give and bequeath my plantacon I now live on all houses orchards fencing & swamp around & all timber or timber trees thereunto belonging. I give amongst my four daughters to each one alike to be divided between my aforesd four daughters ye true estimation & valuation of ye aforesd land to be valued by my two friends John Pallett & Robt. Burrough see that provided that ye first purchaser pay unto ye other three of my aforesd children therir due share as aforesd land is valued at after ye decease of my now wife & yt my sd wife shall not be molested by any of my aforesd children from living peaceably quietiy on ye same plantacon during her natural life; & then ye purchaser of one of my aforesd children shall after ye death of my no. wife be put in possession thereof to her & her heirs forever; Item I ordain yt all my estate of cattle as cows sheep hoggs & all other moveable be divided unto five equal shares both without doors & wthin. between my wife and four children in ye best & dearest may as my two loving friends & trustees shall think fitting. the wch I doe ordaine to be my will & testament. to stand firme forever. it I ordaine that if any one of my aforesd two friends or trustees die before this my last will & testament. be performed that I doe by vertue of this my last will & testament ordain ye survivor of either of ym to choose another in his room to see this my last will & testament. performed as is already mentioned; when my aforesd children shall receive to ye full age; I do ordain to be at ye age of sixteen years; and that then I bequeath that all my children reserve their due part of my moveable estate my executr. & my wife after my debts being paid to see and cause this my last will and testament. to be performed in all things as is aforesd untouched ye ob-

amongst my fourt daughters to each one a like to be divided betwix them affore my daughter
of late Elizabeth & Valuation of my aforesd land to be valued by my law friend John Pellowe & Robt
Burroughs for that provided that my last prouice pay unto other three of my aforesd Children
their due share as my aforesd land is valued at after deductiō of my now wife & of my said
wife shall not be molested by any of my aforesd Children from living indeuorably in
the same plantation during her naturall life, & then & purchase of one of my aforesd
Children shall affre of death of my now wife to possesse thereof to be held
forever. I do command of all my effects of what so ever as fowls & sheep hogs & all other move
ables to be divided into five equall shartes both whiche doores & in between my wife and
four Children in a like & bisenes way as my two living friends & Trustees John Pellowe
follong, The way I do command to be my will & testament to stand & firm for ever. I do further
that if any one of my aforesd two friends or Trustees die before this my last will & Testament
be perfomed that I do by witness of this my last will & Testament ordaine & survivor of
either of them to chose another in his roome to see this my last will & Testament performed
as is already mentioned. When my aforesd Children shall attaine the age of 21st yeare
to attaine age of fifteen years. And that then I do wath that all my Children receiving
their due part of my deuatable effects my selfe & my wife after all my debts being paid
to see & chuse this my last will & testament to be performed while living as my aforesd Children
of a honest & prempre I put my hand & seal this 24th of March 1703.
