estate it hath pleased god to bless me with I

and calves & two heifers with my riding horse
- 2^d I give to my son Tobias Dixon one cow & calf
and one young mare & one heifer # # # #
- 3^d I give to my son James Dixon one cow & calf

- 4th I give to my daughter Frances Dixon one cow
and calf & one heifer # # # #
- 5th I give to my son Robert Dixon one cow and
calf & one heifer # # # #
- 6th I give to my wife christiana Dixon the plan-
tation I now live upon during her life & then
to return to my son Robert Dixon to him & his
heirs for ever # # # #
- 7th I give to my son Tobias Dixon all y^t land upon
all marsh to him & his heirs for ever # #
- 8th I give to my son James Dixon one bod # # #
- 9th I give to my son Robert Dixon one bod # # #
- 10th I give to my son Tobias Dixon four young breeding
sows # # # #
- 11th I give to my wife christiana Dixon the bod bod
with all the remaining part of my goods & chattles

12th I ordaine constitute & apointe my wife christiana
Dixon and my brother in law John Low & Goyne
executors of this my last will & testament
