George the second To all whome these things shall come That for diverse good causes and Considerations but more especially for aid in Consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty pounds of good and lawfull Money for our use paid to our Receiver General of our Revenue in this our Colony and Dominion of Virginia **We have** given granted and confirmed and by these presents for us our heirs and Successors do give grant and confirm unto Garrett Williams of the County of Wight County one certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred and fifty Acres lying and being on the South side of Mattawamy River within the County aforesaid and bounded as followeth to wit **Beginning** at two hundred on the South side of the hornett Swamp a Corner of Richard Muddons Land thence by North South South twenty six poles to a Red Oak tree South thirty five degrees West unto fifty two poles to a Red Oak tree South twenty four poles to a pine tree North fifty five degrees West one hundred thirty four poles to a Black Oak tree North two degrees East eighty six poles to a Red Oak by the side of the hornett Swamp aforesaid thence down the various Courses of the Run of the said Swamp to the beginning **With all** we have holden to holden and pay unto the said William Gooch Esq. our Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief of our said Colony and Dominion at Williamsburgh under the Seal of our said Colony the thirtieth day of October one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven in the first year of our Reigne William Gooch

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George the second To all whome these things shall come That for diverse good causes and Considerations but more especially for aid in Consideration of the sum of ten hundred and fifty pounds of good and lawfull Money for our use paid to our Receiver General of our Revenue in this our Colony and Dominion of Virginia **We have** given granted and confirmed and by these presents for us our heirs and Successors do give grant and confirm unto Sarah Muddons one certain tract or parcel of Swamp Land containing twenty six Acres and eighty seven square poles lying and being in the North woods on the head of Lincolnton River in Princess Anne County and bounded as followeth to wit **Beginning** at a Corner of John Morrisons Standing meadow Locust trees and running thence along the said Locust trees South Easterly thirty nine degrees fifty four poles to a Corner of Red Oak of Robert Muddons Deeds thence along the said Muddons line South Easterly forty two degrees one hundred and ninety six poles to a Red Oak thence along the said Muddons South Easterly twenty one degrees seventy two poles to a Black Gum standing in the said Muddons line thence North Easterly fifty two degrees fifty one poles to a Gum standing in the said Muddons line thence along the said Muddons North Easterly forty two degrees forty three poles to a small Red Oak North Easterly two degrees seventy
