**Beginning** at two hundred thre Score and sixe feet from the corner of  
Nicholas Murdons Land lying by Bushy Aline Southly twenty sixe poles to a Red Oak  
tree South thirtysix degrees West unty two poles to a Chestnut tree Weston  
hundred and sixtysix pole to a pine tree North fiftie two degrees Westone  
hundred and forty four pole to Black Oak then North two degrees East eighty six  
pole to a locust tree by the side of the horn of swamp aforesaid then along the various  
courses of the Run of the said swamp to beginning **With** a certaine  
lode or colde all yel lowe and paynkinge provided it be within the latitudine  
trustyan Colloball and William Hooch Esq: Our Lieutenant Governor and  
Comender in Chief of our said Colony and Dominion at Williamsburg under  
the Seal of our said Colony the thirteenth day of October Anno domini MDCXCVI

parcell of swamp Land containing fiftysix acres and eightyeven poles  
lying and bounden the North side of the head of Mattaponi River in  
Princetown County aforesaid bounded as followeth (to wit) **Beginning** at a  
corner between John Merriweather standing in a tree and running  
thence along the said Mattaponi South Easterly thirtynine degrees fiftysix  
poles to a corner where a tree of Robert Murdon standeth thence along the said  
Murdons line South Easterly fiftytwo degrees one hundred and six  
poles to a tree standing in the said Murdons line  
thence South Easterly fiftytwo degrees fiftyonen poles to a gum standing in  
the same place and thence along the said Murdons line North Easterly fortytwo  
degrees fortythree poles to a small hollow tree North Easterly two degrees southerly
