

This Indenture made & Second Day of March in the year of our Lord God one thousand two hundred twenty nine thirty Between William Achis & Sarah his wife both of Prince George County in the Colony of Virginia of the one part & John Murdon of Norfolk County in the same Colony with her selfe the other part said William Achis & Sarah his wife for consideration of the sum of five shillings Current money of Virginia paid by said John Murdon in hand paid by said John Murdon in the receipt whereof they doth acknowledge the said bargain & sale by the presents doth bargain & sell unto said John Murdon one tract or plantation of Land by estimation one hundred & fifty acres more or less within the bounds which said Land is situated in Prince George County the bounds as followeth to wit beginning beginning at a white oak standing on the run Pidd & so binding on the Land of William Denby & on the Land of William Bonkis & on the Land of William Nicholson & on the Land of John Hopkins and on the Land of Anthony Wobbs to include of said one hundred & fifty acres of Land more or less within said bounds whereof fifty acres of said one hundred & fifty was devised by said William Achis by the last will & Testament of his father John Achis deceased other hundred was bought by said William Achis as records of Prince George County will make appear with the deviation and severances of said Land and heritaments & promises with appurtenance to have and to hold of said Testament & promises unto of said John Murdon his heirs & assigns for during the Term of one whole year next ensuing the death of the Testator that by virtue thereof of Statute for Transferring us into possession he shall have and hold may bring & actually possess himselfe to be enabled to take receipt of a grant & release of all promises to him his heirs & assigns for ever In witness whereof the Testator & Sarah his wife have set their hands & seals of day by year first above written in the presence of Friends Amt At a Court held the 4 Day of March 1729

This Indenture made the third Day of March in the year of our Lord God one thousand two hundred twenty nine thirty Between William Achis & Sarah his wife both of Prince George County in the Colony of Virginia of the one part & John Murdon of Norfolk County in the same Colony of the other part whereas the said William Achis & Sarah his wife by Indenture bearing date the 6th instant before this Bargain & Sale unto said John Murdon his executors & assigns one tract or plantation of Land by estimation one hundred & fifty acres more or less within the bounds as followeth to wit beginning at a white oak standing on a run called Pidd & so binding on the Land of William Denby & on the Land of William Nicholson & on the Land of John Hopkins & on the Land of Anthony Wobbs to include of said one hundred & fifty acres of Land within said bounds whereof fifty acres of said one hundred & fifty were willed by the last will & Testament of his father John Achis deceased to his wife Sarah Achis as records of Prince George County will make appear which said Land is situated in Prince George County to him & said John Murdon his executors for a Term of one whole year to wit by said Indenture in consideration of the sum of Twenty three pounds Current money of Virginia to them land paid by said John Murdon in the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge & doth her by her to acquire discharge of said Indenture from over man & parcel of their of her sum of five shillings Virginia paid by said Indenture
