WITNESSETH that the aforesaid John and James do hereby mutally agree that ye said John Munden shall first at his own proper cost and charge cause to be laid out to and for ye said James Harrison the quantity of three hundred acres acres of land beginning at the boundary line between Joel Cornick an him ye said James and running southward and being formerly part of the land and estate of Capt. Francis Morse dec'd and also that ye said John Munden shall and upon the bounds of his ye said James Harrisons land and whomso run out as aforesaid begin and layout his ye said John Mundens land and bound the same In Witness whereof they the aforesaid parties have hereunto set their hands and bind each other in the penal sum of fifty pounds sterling for the performances hereof the day and year above written.
