PROOF We heard by the Grace of God of Great Britain, France and Ireland,
King Defender of the Faith to all Nations these Presents shall conveygating
Whereas by an Inquisition Interrogatory taken in the County of Norfolk the thirtenth
Day of August in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Ninety eight
by Virtue of a Warrant directed to Samuel Bowes Yeoman Receiver for the said
County It appears that George Tucker formerly of the said County died Seized of a
Parcel of Land near Norfolk Town in the said County lying between the Land
whereon Edward Portlock then lived and the Land of John Morris which is
found to extend to us from the said George Tucker and contains in quantity
half an Acre AND Willing Robert Tucker of the Borough of Norfolk in the said
County of Norfolk Yeoman hath made humble Suit to William Gooch Esq our Lieut
Governor and Commander in Chief of the Colony and Dominion of Virginia
and hath obtained a Grant for the same / Therefore know ye that for divers
good Causes and Considerations but more especially for and in Consideration of one
Pound of Tobacco for our use already paid to our Receiver General of our Revenue
in this our said Colony and Dominion M^r HALE given Granted and Confirmed
and by these Presents for us our Heirs and Successors do give Grant and Confer
unto the said Robert Tucker and to his Heirs and Assigns forever ALL and every
part and parcel of the said half Acre of Land AND ALL Woods Woods
Swamps Marshes Long grasses Meadow Landings and his due Share of all Crops
Mines and Dugrees as well discovered as not discovered within the bounds aforesaid
and being part of the said quantity of half an Acre of Land and the River Water
and Watercourses therein contained together with the Privileges of Hunting
Hawking Trapping Trouting and all other Profts Commodities and Handworks
whatsoever to the same or any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining
TO HAVE HOLD Possess and Enjoy the said half Acre of Land and all other the
before granted Privileges and every part thereof with their and every of their Appurtenances
