This Indenture made the 6<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred forty four-five Between John Munden of Princess Ann County of the one part and Moses Roberts of the same place and county aforesaid of the other part. WITNESSETH that the said John Munden for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money to him in hand paid by the above said Moses Roberts before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt of which and which the said John Munden hereby acknowledges have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and rents to the aforesaid Moses Roberts one parcel of land situate in the county of Princess Ann containing by estimation seventy five acres more or less beginning at a white oak on the land of the William Brock then running northerly by a line of marked trees to a white oak a corner tree then running along the old road by a line of marked trees to a white gum then running southwesterly to a white gum a corner tree then running by a line of marked trees to the first station and the reversion and reversion remainder and remainder rents issues and profits thereof. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land and premises unto the said Moses Roberts his executors and assigns from the day and date hereof for and during the full end and term of six months from thence first ensuing and fully to be complete and in? to the intent that by virtue of these presents and of the statute for transferring uses into possession the said Moses Roberts may be in the actual possession of the premises and may be enabled to take and accept of a grant and release of the same to him his heirs and assigns respective forever.
