I also give my hand mill to my son John Munden to him and his heirs and my great Bible I give to my son John Munden to him and his heirs forever. Item, the land bought of John Lamount being in quantity fifty acres more or less I give and bequeath unto my son Aguilla Munden to him and his heirs forever. Also I give one bed of furniture and his bed stand to my son Aguilla Munden to him and his heirs forever. Item: I give my Negro boy Will, I give and bequeath to my son Stephen Munden to him and his heirs forever and I also give to my son Stephen Munden one bed of furniture and bed stand to him and his heirs forever. I give and bequeath unto Mary Whichard one low bed of furniture and bed stand to her and her heirs forever. Item: I give and bequeath all my personal Estate that is not already given away to be equally divided amongst my surviving children. Item: I do make ordain and appoint my son John Munden my whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament. In Witness where of I have set my hand and seal the day first above written. Item: one cow and calfs I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Leggett to him and his heirs forever. Item: one cow and Calf I give and bequeath unto my grandson Jno. Brock to him and his heirs forever.
