Son Tully Sney one Feather Bed & Furniture
one young Mare two years Old and one
Heifer one year and a half Old and his Heirs
to him and the Heirs of his Body. I do Give
and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary
either side one Feather Bed and Furniture
and one Two Gallon Pot and one pewter
Bason holding five Quarts to her and the
Heirs of her Body lawfully begetten
I do Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
Elizabeth Banks one Feather Bed & Furniture
and one four Gallon Iron Pot and two
Pewter Basons holding five pints and
one Two year Old Heifer white pulled to
her and the Heirs of her Body lawfully begetten
I do Give and Bequeath unto my Son
Peter Sney Executor of this my last Will and
Testament and if there should be any brothers

at my Wife's House mentioned in my Will
I desire they may be equally divided between
my two Sons Andrew & John & Sally Sorey and
my two Daughters Lucy & Elizabeth and Eleanor
Banks I desire all other Wills and Warrant
thence only this to be my last Will & Testament
