 but of perfect mind & memory I give and bequeath unto my Son John Simmons
 & my Daughter Betty Herbut all my Land lying and being in pricapse Anne County
 by up at the head of black Water River lying on Flagole Run containing 355 Acres
 to be equally divided between my said Son John Simmons and my said Daugh-
 ter Betty Herbut Item I give and bequeath satisfy and confirm unto my Young
 est son William Simmons his plantation and tract of Land wherewith I now dwell
 with all its Rights and profits thereunto belonging containing 255 Acres Item
 I give unto my said Daughter Betty Herbut all my Castle Except that said
 marked in my proper Mark Belonging to my Son William Simmons Item I
 give unto my two Grandsons Thomas Herbut & Jacob Herbut four Pounds Current
 rent money which money its my Desire shall be laid out in the Educating &
 Schooling of the two aforesaid when they shall be capable of taking the same provided
 that my said Daughter Betty Herbut and John Simmons should die without
 issue of Body lawfully begotten that then the said Land shall return to the said
 Thomas & John Herbut to be equally divided between them It is also my Will
 that if my Son William Simmons should die without heirs lawfully begot-
 ten that then the said Land shall return to my Son John Simmons & Betty
 Herbut and their issue lawfully begotten of their Bodies But if my said
 Son and Daughter John Simmons and Betty Herbut dies without heirs
 of their Bodies lawfully begotten then the said Land shall be for the poor of
 the Parish & Parochy All my Estate both real & personal its my Desire may be
 Appraised & Equally Divided Among my three Children viz John Simmons
 William Simmons & Betty Herbut & also that my two Sons may Be bound
 w/out in Order to Educate them & Qualifie them for Business I Likewise
 nominate make and ordain Mr Adam Cook & Wm Southwood Simmons Esq
 of this my last Will and Testament & do hereby utterly disallow Revoke
 and disannul all and every other former Testamente Wills and Legacies
 by me in any way before named written and bequeathed testifying and con-
 ferring this and no other to my last Will & Testament In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the Day and Year above written
