 the Earth & common mother of us all to be decently buried after the manner of
 my loving friends & children & for what worldly good it hath pleased the Lord
 bless me with I give & bequeath as followeth. I give & bequeath to my
 son William Cartwright one shilling to him this hour being in full of his part of
 my Estate. I give to my son in law James Cotton one shilling being his full
 part & my daughter Katherine of my Estate from me. I give & bequeath to my
 daughter Sarah Hooley one shilling being her full part of my Estate. I give
 & bequeath unto my daughter Frances Clayder one shilling being her full part of
 my Estate. I give & bequeath to my son John Cartwrights Children one shil-
 ling amongst them all. I give & bequeath to my daughter Ann Hooley one
 suit of second mourning cloaths which I have worn myself. I give and
 bequeath to my son Thomas Cartwright my negro wench called Lucy and all the
 rest of my Estate which I have not already given both real & personal and I do
 make & ordain this to be my last will & Testament and I do desire that my son
 William & my son Thomas Cartwright should be my true & lawful Executors of this my
 last will & Testament Given from under my hand & seals this 23: of October 1730
 her mark.
