It: I give unto James & Eiland one large powder dish. It: I give unto my granddaughter Eliz: Eiland one powder dish. It: I give unto John Heath one bed & Bolster & Coverlet & one Iron postle. It: I give all of remainer part of my Estate to be equally divided betw: on my four children they paying all my debts & receiving all that is justly due to me. -- So I appoint my friend Francis morfe as a Trustee to see this my last will & Testament performed according to my desire as whereunto I have set my hand & seal this 3rd of Jan^y: 1722
