

On the Name of God Amen I James while being sick & weak of body but of sound mind & memory thank be given to almighty God & being sensible of the certainty of Death though it time thereof is most uncertainly knowne
I nowe of my selfe & bound myselfe to make & appoint this my last will and Testament
in manner & form following as I purpose & give & bequeath my substance & effects of all my rightes Goods &
chaleys & to have through my ministrations of a Church my wife Elizabeth & sonnes and my selfe say for her
to be buried at my Counter house as aforesaid shall think fit.

I nowe give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth four Cows and Calves with their future increase and
her hogg & sow & two hogs & eight young hogs & all her future increase to have & keepe for her
Eyes without charge & to pay her her charges for rade and helpe of my weareing Clothe

I nowe give & bequeath to my grandson William Bobb one two year old heifer with all her future increase
of him & his heirs for Eyes - I nowe give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary the gather bed who wounth
to warthall of furme two thounds belonging to no small Iron pot & one Iron pell & a chalot that do belongeth
to my Sister Mary Rintone head of cattle young and old having her portion boath of the young and old
cattle with all their future increase to her & her heirs for ever twenty & four hogs & young & old having
her portion boath of 4 young & old hogs with all their future increase to her & her heirs for ever
Sheep young & old having her portion boath of the young & old Sheep with all their future increase to her
her heirs for rade and & other half of my weareing Clothe and as for all & sort of my worldly Estate
give & bequeath unto my Sonne Benj Salley making him sole Executour of this my last will & Testament &
witnessing all other wills & Testaments in witness whereof I have set my hand and doth
this tenth day of November 1716
