In the Name of God Amen I Affell Hancock bequeath my Soul to almighty God who gave it me that Hoping that he will be pleased to receive it in his Everlasting Joy I think it fit and Convenient to make this my Last will and Testament.

Bequeath unto my Brother William Hancock all my Land here and all Currieturah to him and to his heirs for ever

I Give to my Sister Mary Hancock my Mare and foal up in the woods: and one Cow and Calfs and as much good stuff as will make her a Suite of Cloaths and one Ewe and Lamb

I give to my Sister Elizabeth Hancock my Negro Dick and one Cow and Calfs and one Ewe & Lamb the said Negro to her and to her heirs for ever

I Give to my Sister Sarah Hancock my horse pepper and one Cow and Calfs and one Ewe & Lamb I Give to my Brother James Hancock one heifer about two or three years old and one Ewe Lamb & one Small Can

I Give to my Sister Elizabeth Hancock one heifer and one Ewe Lamb

I Give to my Brother George Hancock my best Suite of Apparell and all whatsoever he the said George Hancock is in my Debt

I Give to James Wytherd an order of the Generall Court which I have against him

I Give all the remaining part of my Estate be it of what nature kind or quality soever to my Brother William Hancock he paying all my Just Debts

I make and Ordaine my Brother William Hancock my whole and Sole Executor of this my Last will
