In the Name of God Amen I Benjamin Burrough being sick & weak of body but sound mind & memory thanks be given to almighty god & being conscious of the certainty of death tho: & time there of most uncertain & being desirous to settle that small Temporary Estate which hath pleased god in mercy to lend me: Do therefore make this my last will & Testament in manner & in following

First & principally I bequeath my soule to almighty god my heavenly father true & hoping that int through y^e blessed Death & passion of my only saviour Iesus Christ to receive forgiveness & remission of my sins & of ones & my body to y^e earth from whence it came to be & to be decently buried as y^e discretion of my Eldest hereafter named: - I give & bequeath to my son Robert Burrough that tract of land whereon Burrough now lives on formerly belonging to his uncle Ab: Burrough to him & his heirs for ever I give & bequeath unto my dear & loving wife Frances the plantation ... & now living for during her natural life & after unto my son: Arthur Burrough & to his heirs for ever if my son the said Burrough be minded to settle on y^e said land when he comes to y^e age of one & twenty years then his mother to assign him a part at her discretion whereon to live but in case my two sons Robert & Arthur should die both of them without children then I do give both those tracts of land to my daughter Eliza Burrough & her heirs for ever. I give to each of my sons a gun & apparel I give & bequeath to my son Robt my mill after his mothers decease & I give to my daughter Eliza six p^{ts} to be paid in money at y^e day of her marriage & also a feather bed & furniture to be delivered her at y^e day of marriage I give unto my well beloved wife Francis Burrough all & singular y^e rest of my personal Estate of what kind nature or quality so ever after all my debts is fully paid & in case my wife should be with child at my death then I do give my mind to that child if it be a son after my wife's decease & if a daughter I give y^e negro man to my daughter Eliza after her mothers decease & do name my son & my said well beloved wife Francis my whole & sole leg^{al} of this my last will & Testament I write & seal in presence of my hand & signed my name this 11 day of March Anno Domini 1719
